\$3,910,261 Financial Assistance (at cost)

The cost of providing free or discounted health services for those who could not afford to pay and met the criteria for financial assistance.

\$273,944 Community Health Improvement

The cost of providing activities and programs aimed at improving community health, including assessing community needs and program administration.

\$130,919 Health Professions Education

The cost of educating future medical professionals in programs that result in a degree, certificate or license in a health care field.

\$75,240 Research

The expense of conducting research studies and publicizing the results to increase the health knowledge of community members.

\$2,483,581 Medicaid (at cost)

The unpaid costs of public programs for those with low income or a disability.

These calculations are based on Internal Revenue Service Form 990, Schedule H. Additional benefits provided by Presence St. Mary's Hospital include \$7.9 million in bad debt expense and \$12.6 million in Medicare shortfall.
