2018 Associate Giving Campaign FAQ

When does this campaign start?

The campaign will kick off on Monday, Oct. 8 and run through Friday, Nov. 2, 2018. All full time and part time associates will receive a personalized letter from Mark A. Frey, President & CEO, AMITA Health, to their home address the first week of the campaign with a response form. They also will receive electronic communications from itstartswithus@presencehealth.org and their ministry leader with an electronic link to the AGC website.

What are my options for designation?

1. Your Ministry, to support the priority programs and initiatives at your place of work
 - Gifts will support patient care programs and infrastructure improvement at each ministry. Specific projects will be identified at completion of the campaign dependent upon total dollars raised.
2. Associate Relief, to support Presence Health associates during times of personal crisis
 - System fund that can be accessed by associates in times of hardship.
3. Community Outreach and Care for the Vulnerable, to support the health and wellness of individuals and families served across Presence Health
 - System fund that will provide support to targeted people in need or address community needs as determine by Presence Health leadership.

How can I make a gift?

- Fill out the AGC form (enclosed in direct mail or available at ministries) and drop it off, either at your local ministry (campaign committee to determine location) or mail to the Presence Health Foundation at:

What if I want to make a gift after the campaign ends?

Individuals will be able to make a gift throughout the year by logging on to PeopleSoft Self Service, visiting <https://www.presencehealth.org/it-starts-with-us>, filling out the Associate Giving form and returning to your local campaign committee or Presence Health Foundation office.

When will my payroll deduction begin?

Your contribution through payroll deduction will begin on Jan. 2, 2019, and will be reflected on the Jan. 25, 2019, paycheck. Your gift will be reflected on your paycheck as Deduction- [Fund] and will continue until the time you determine. After the campaign closes on Nov. 2, 2018, associates will be able to manage their deduction through PeopleSoft Employee Self Service.

How will I know if my payroll deduction went through?

All individuals who enroll in payroll deduction will receive a confirmation email once the campaign ends which will detail their amount and designation.

What if I want to change my deduction amount or designation?

During the campaign and after, you will be able to manage your deduction through PeopleSoft Employee Self Service. Click on “Voluntary Deductions” under the Payroll and Compensation folder to review, add or update your deduction.

I’m already signed up for payroll deduction. What will happen to my current gifts?

All current donors on payroll deduction (with the exception of ELT/SLT/Ministry Presidents) will receive an email from itstartswithus@presencehealth.org the week of Oct. 8, noting that their current deduction will be discontinued as of Dec. 23, 2018 and encouraging the renewal of their gift through our new channels.

I work for a non-Presence Health entity (Sodexo, Alverno, Rehab Care, Unidine, etc.), but feel connected to the ministry where I work. Can I still support the Associate Giving Campaign?

What will happen to my gift once we become part of AMITA Health?

All funds will remain where they were designated and spent according to donor intent. As we integrate it is important that we continue to demonstrate the commitment of our associates to the mission of our organization. Donating to the Associate Giving Campaign is one way to do so.

Has Presence Health leadership supported this campaign?

All members of the Executive Leadership Team, Senior Leadership Team and Ministry Presidents have committed to this campaign. System Vice Presidents, System Directors and Ministry Regional Leadership were solicited in August and September to ensure leaders are supporting the campaign before we ask all associates to participate.

Will my manager or my leadership team know the amount of my gift?

No. The Presence Health Foundation does not share gift levels of any associate. All gifts are confidential. Leadership solicitations did include a range, which is best practice, however the true focus of this campaign is participation. All gifts make a difference.
